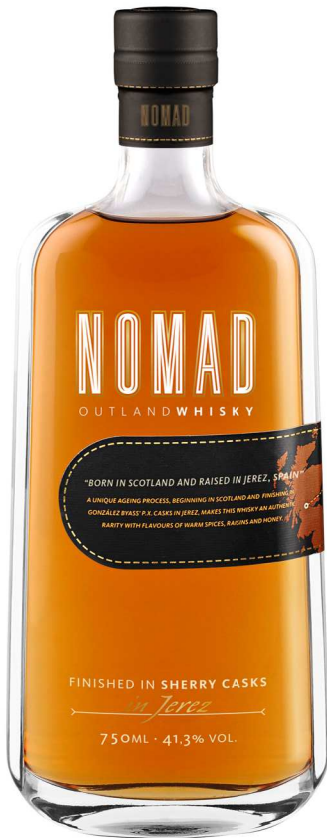


NOMAD

Technical Information

Type: Blended Whisky

Alcohol: 41.3%

Ageing: 5-8 years in Scotland, 1 year in PX casks in Jerez.

No Alcohol coefficient: minimum 300 mg/ 100 ml a.abs

Total Sugars: 12 g/l

Dry Extracts: 14.3 g/l

González Byass

González Byass was founded in Jerez in 1835 by Manuel Maria González. At the young age of 23 he decided to dedicate his professional life to the production and commercialisation of Sherry wines and spirits. In 1844 the first barrels of Tio Pepe were exported to London. Then in 1855 the company's UK distributor Robert Blake Byass was made a partner in order to strengthen links with the UK. However nowadays the company is controlled by the González family, now in its fifth generation. González Byass has since become a recognised brand worldwide dedicated to the production of quality brands and spirits.

Nomad

Nomad is a quality blended Whisky born and aged in Scotland and finished in Jerez. A unique whisky which has been aged both in its homeland Scotland and, in the birthplace of González Byass, Jerez. This premium blend, made up of 40% Malt Whisky, is aged in Scotland for 5 to 8 years and then transferred to Jerez. The whisky is then aged in American oak casks which previously contained old Pedro Ximénez Sherry in the historic González Byass cellars.

Ageing Process

Following rigorous experiments with many different sherry casks (that were used to age Fino, Oloroso and Pedro Ximénez Sherries) our master blenders found that the best finish for this special Whisky came from the Pedro Ximénez casks, left to mature in the magic atmosphere of our Jerez cellars. Its ageing in these barrels (used to mature old Pedro Ximénez in this unique atmosphere) make the Whisky a rarity worth mentioning. The unusual ambience of our century-old winery in Jerez, subject to changing temperatures, humidity and maritime influences, and imbued with the native yeasts that are so unique to our cellars, give Nomad its particular and incomparable personality.

Tasting Note

Bright topaz coloured whisky. Inviting aromas with a malty fragrance and well-integrated alcohol. Reminiscent of oak and Sherry due to its ageing in American oak sherry casks. Smooth and elegant on the palate with prominent flavours of raisins, honey and a distinctive bouquet, as a result of the finishing of the Whisky in Pedro Ximenez sherry casks. A long finish, pleasant with hints of vanilla and dried fruits. A very elegant whisky with a complex aftertaste.
