UNIQUE AGING PROCESS

In Ireland, it is aged for 3 years in casks that have previously contained Bourbon and then they travel to Jerez, where they age for 1 year, in highly selected casks of our emblematic Oloroso Alfonso.

TASTING NOTES

Amber-colored whisky with bright golden reflections. In the nose is very complex, with notes of vanilla, spices, and nuts in the presence of aromas of quality malt. It has a wine character due to its aging in Dry Oloroso Sherry Cask, making it intense and pleasant on the palate, with a touch of oak. The double aging in Bourbon and Oloroso casks gives it a marked softness on the palate with a long and elegant aftertaste.
