## A classic expression of a grand terroir

**Grape variety:** 97% Syrah from old vines and 3% Roussanne

**Terroir:** From the best terroirs of the Hermitage hill. Granitic soil.

Vinification: Hand-picked in small bins. After one month maceration under controlled

temperature, the wine is matured for 12 months in oak barrels (15% new oak,

the rest in 1 to 4 year old barrels) depending on the vintage.

Tasting notes

**Color:** Brilliant, profound purple.

**Nose:** The nose shows great purity and finesse, with notes of peppery raspberry,

candied fruit and fine spices.

Palate: A well-balanced wine with good structure, integrated tannins, and elegant,

long finish.

Service This great wine will be ready to drink after 2 to 3 years, but can age for 8 to 10

years.

Serve at 18°C/64°F and decant if possible.

Food matches Perfect with wild hare or Mexican chicken molé (simmered in spices and

chocolate).
