

AOP COTES DU ROUSSILLON ROSE

The Saint-Roch vineyard is located in the heart of Roussillon, South of France, close to the Spanish border. Halfway between the Pyrenees and the Mediterranean sea, the Queribus Cathar castle, set on a steep cliff, overlooks the valley and the mosaic of our vineyard.



Stony, black schist soil, with loam, in the Agly Valley.

Varietals:

Old Vines, 60% Grenache - 40% Syrah

Winegrowing:

High Environmental Value level 3 vineyard. Sustainable, low-impact farming.

Bush vines for the Grenache, spur prune for the Syrah.

Winemaking:

Selection of the best bunches in the vineyard.

Grapes are pressed directly without a maceration to get a light color. Alcoholic fermentation at 16°C. Bottling in November.

Jean-Marc Lafage's tasting notes:

A gregariously friendly rosé with floral aromas and delicate strawberry flavors. With a lively acidity but a decadent richness of fruit, this wine tastes like summer in a glass and is the perfect way to welcome guests to your next BBQ.
