TENUTE ROSSETTI

Tenute Rossetti is located near Florence, in the heart of Tuscany and is part of the Farnese Vini group. The name Farnese in the Abruzzo region dates back to 1538 with wine production beginning in 1994. Rossetti is a family winery dating back to the 10th century that is today a modern Tuscan winery and a leading producer of Chianti. Rossetti

boasts passion in every step of the wine making process, with a state-of-the-art facility and an experienced and qualified staff. The core business is represented by well-known Tuscan appellations, such as Chianti, Chianti Classico and Toscana Rosso.

WINEMAKING

This Chianti Classico Riserva is produced from Sangiovese 85% and Cabernet Sauvignon 15%. Following manual harvest the grapes are gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperatures, alternating low and medium (between 16 ° C and 24 ° C) for 10 days, with macro-oxygenation. The wine is then aged in French oak barrels for 24 months and at least 5 months in the bottle before release.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine is ruby red with a garnet rim. On the nose aromas of sweet spices and hints of berries. A delicate wine that shows a slight sweetness on the palate and the elegant simplicity of a typical Chianti wine.

Ideal with red meats, game, soup and mature cheese.
