NOMAD is the only Outland Whisky ® because the majority of malt whiskies are finished in Sherry Casks that have been sent to Scotland from Jerez. Now the product is born in different whisky cradles to be finished in Gonzalez Byass Sherry Casks in Jerez. This way, it travels around the globe to find perfection and going beyond the unwritten rules of whisky.

UNIQUE AGEING PROCESS

A premium blended whisky produced from 30 different malt and grain whiskies from Speyside (The Highlands, Scotland) with an average age of 6 years. The resulting blend is then refined through a minimum of 1 year of aging in old Pedro Ximenez casks, in the unique conditions of the historic centenary cellars of González Byass in Jerez. This double aging firstly in Scotland and then in Jerez, is unique and makes Nomad Outland Whisky® a true rarity.

TASTING NOTES

Bright amber in color, Nomad shows a concentrated aroma with notes of malt, wood, and the unmistakable hint of Pedro Ximenez sherry. On the palate it is very smooth and elegant, initial flavors of raisings and honey build to a long and pleasant finish with notes of vanilla and dried fruits. A very elegant yet complex whisky.
