AOP CÔTES DU ROUSSILLON

VARIETIES

Grenache, Syrah

TERROIR

Stony, black schist soil, with loam, nearby Maury, in the Agly Valley at 300m of altitude, at the heart of Roussillon, South of France, near the Spanish border.

High Environmental Value level 3 vineyard. Sustainable, low-impact farming, dry grown. Bush vines for the Grenache, spur prune for the Syrah.

WINE-MAKING PROCESS

Hand picked, selection of the best bunches in the vineyard. Grapes are pressed directly without maceration to get a fresh and pale color. Native yeast for the alcoholic fermentation. Aged on lees for 3 months in concrete tanks. 20% of the blend is fermented and aged in demi-muids. A few barrels have done the malolactic fermentation for a better complexity.

TASTING

A gregariously friendly rosé, with floral aromas and delicate strawberry flavours, with a lively acidity but a decadent richness of fruit.

WINE PAIRINGS

This wine tastes like summer in a glass and is the perfect way to welcome guests to your next BBQ.
